STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

If a student is not accepted into the college, the enrollment agreement will be cancelled, and Campus will refund all money paid within thirty days.

<u>Student's Right to Cancel:</u> Students have the right to cancel their enrollment agreement for a program of study, without any penalty or obligations, through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh (7th) calendar day after the student signs the enrollment agreement, whichever is later, and receive a full refund of all monies paid to the school minus the application fee of \$50.00 (\$200.00 for cosmetology and barbering programs).

After the end of the cancellation period, students have the right to stop school at any time; and they have the right to receive a pro-rata refund if they have completed 60 percent or less of the scheduled hours in the current term in their program through the last day of attendance.
